A Special Session meeting of the Board of School Trustees of the Vincennes Community School Corporation was held at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, April 6, 2015 at Tecumseh-Harrison Elementary School. Those present for the meeting were President Pat Hutchison, Vice President Karla Smith, Secretary Barbara Toole, Members Aaron Bauer and Lynne Bobe, and Superintendent Greg Parsley.

This Special Session was held with Tecumseh-Harrison PTO parents and members of the community for a discussion of a possible elementary building project.

Superintendent Parsley explained to the audience that the Vincennes Community School Corporation was opening dialogue for the future of our elementary buildings. Several options have been suggested, from building a new "Mega" Elementary School to renovating the current buildings, as well as moving to three elementary buildings and reconfiguring Riley Elementary School for a possible Alternative Education building.

Board Members heard comments from the community on their views for the future of the elementary buildings. Questions and answers were entertained from those present.

Mr. Parsley stated a Feasibility Study would be made of the various scenarios and a decision made at a later date.

All community members were thanked for their input and the meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
